An iconic aerial image of J-5 Ranger by Kos, displayed using the historical 'cyanotype' technique of exposing light onto emulsion on 70-year old cotton sail cloth of J-4 Endeavour owned by Sir Thomas Sopwith. This dual-J combination is mounted on a carbon fibre sail of J-7 Velsheda, built in 1933 in the UK by Camper & Nicholsons for Mr W.L. Stephenson.

The colourful, vibrant images are presented on the 50-year old mainsail of the 12-metre Courageous, defender in 1977 of the America's Cup for the New York Yacht Club. She was helmed by "Mouth of the South" Ted Turner, founder of CNN. His starting helmsman was the legendary Dennis Conner. Courageous successfully defended the Cup from challenger Australia 1 owned by Alan Bond.

The 2nd skin of the main displays its Union Jack. Between the two mainsail skins is suspended a fragment of King George V's Britannia, which the King ordered to be scuttled on 10th July 1936. The 90-year old sail is made by Ratsey & Lapthorn, the historic sailmaker since 1790 and leading sailmaker to the America's Cup since 1851.

The art piece has been signed by Sir Ben on the occasion of the Royal Yacht Squadron being the Challenger of Record with its yacht INEOS Britannia.

The artwork is protected and encapsulated in a custommade UV acrylic case and can either be wall-mounted or displayed with colour-controlled lighting on its transparent acrylic base. A wooden transportation box is included, custom-made by Cadogan Tate.
