Meet the Crew | Ben Cornish



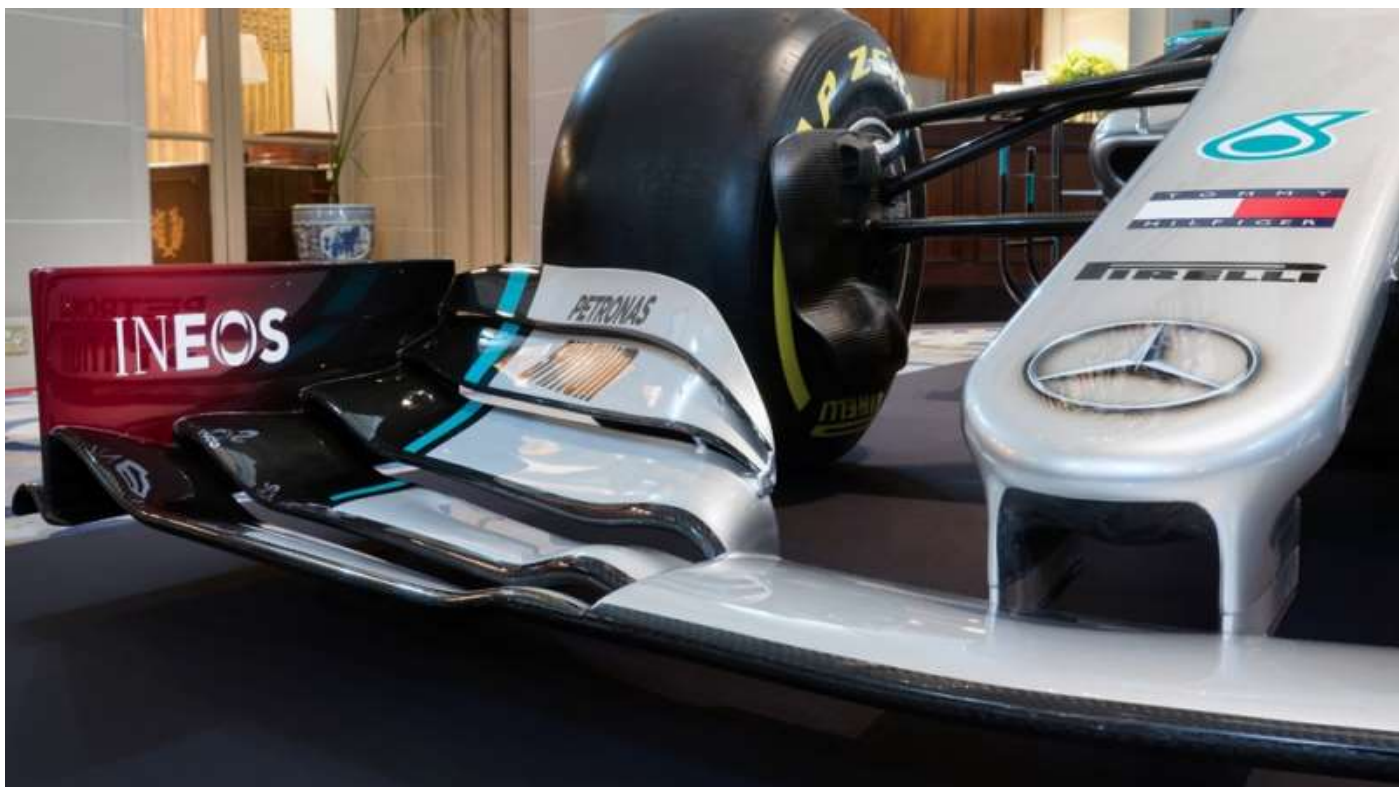

Ben Cornish grew up sailing on the Exe Estuary and from an early age had ambitions to compete at the Olympics. As a rising star in the British Sailing Team, first competing in the Laser followed by the Finn class - the single-handed heavyweight dinghy – there was potential for Olympic selection, until the class lost its Olympic status for Paris 2024.

The news forced Ben to take an unexpected change in direction, the America's Cup, joining former Finn training partner and Olympic gold medallist Giles Scott for his first America's Cup campaign. Ben is one of only two INEOS TEAM UK 'Rebels', a full-time sailing intern, immersed within and receiving support from the senior sailing team.
